





**OVERVIEW:**

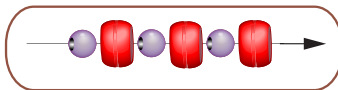
Make a basic triangle with cylinder and seed beads. Increase corners and sides for desired size. Zip stitch ten (10) triangles to form a 3-D "Puffy" Pentagram Ornament. Stuff with fiber-fill. This star ornament measures is 25x50mm, yet light enough to hang.

**MATERIALS:** (To make ten (10) triangles)

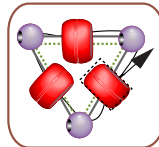
- 5 grams  A - 15/0 seed bead
  - 7 grams  B - 11/0 cylinder bead
  - 7 grams  C - 11/0 cylinder bead
- Poly-Fiber-Fill (for stuffing ornament)

- TOOLS AND NOTIONS:**  
 Braided Wire = 6# Fireline®  
 Scissors (for braided wire)  
 Beading Needles - Size 12  
 Step-up

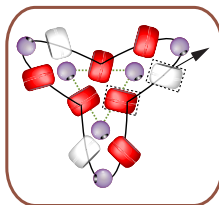
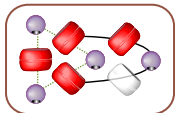
**1** Thread 24 inches (61cm). Leave a 6 inch (15.2cm) tail, string as follows:



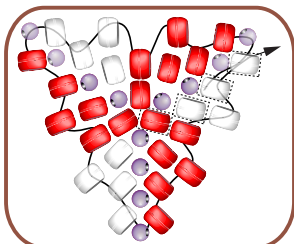
**2** Form circle: Needle forward, exit (B) prior to start position.



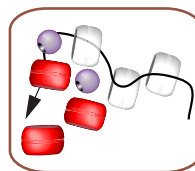
**3** Corner Increase: Pick up [C,A,B], skip over (A). The (A) is a spacer bead. Step-up after each row. Tension is moderate.



**4** Side Increase: As shown (11- up beads per side).



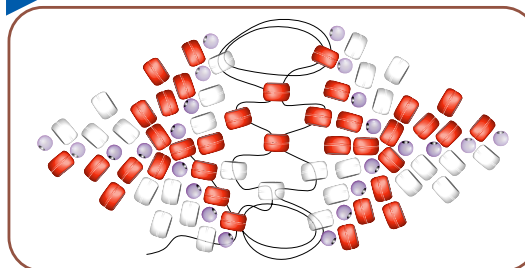
**5** End Corner Increase: Pass thru (C,A,B).



**6** Add Zip-to row:



**7** Zip-up sides:



**8** Zip-up five (5) triangles, alternating red and white.



**9** Continue zipping up the exterior sides, and stuff with fiber-fill prior to closing.

**10** Place one (1) cylinder between each (A) in openings. Design an appropriate method of display.
