






MATERIALS:

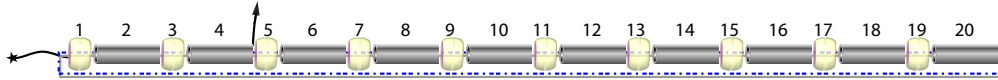
- 4 grams  15/0 seed bead - A
- 7.5 grams  11/0 cylinder bead - B
- 7 grams  #1 bugle bead - C

TOOLS AND NOTIONS:

- Braided Wire = 6# Fireline®
- Scissors (for braided wire)
- Beading Needles - Size 12

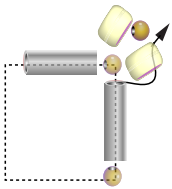
Peyote a basic star with bugle, cylinder, and seed beads. Think jewelry, ornaments, or flowers.

1 Thread a "stopper bead" on 60 inches (152.4cm) Leave a 6 inch (15.2cm) tail, string as follows: (NOTE: two (2) bugle sets per star point). Bugle set = (B,C,B,C)



2 Pass thru (A) to form a circle. Pass thru all beads again and EXIT the second (C).

3 Corner Increase: (B,A,B) between each (C). Increase tension. Step up after each row.



4 Side Increase: (B,A,B), pass thru B, add (C). Increase tension with "stopper bead" and working thread. (NOTE: Corner increases alternate up/down positions. Work rows on a dowel or ring mandrel.) Continue corner and side increases to desired height: (example: 6 spine beads).



5 End Corner and Side Increases. Pass thru (A) and (B) and add a "zipper" row. Pass in FRONT of the, (A) and thru the (B).






6 "Zip-up" side, circle around top bead. Pass thru the (A) and (B) and continue next "zipper" and join row. Complete each star point. Needle exits an (A) in the crown.



7 Crown: (2A) between each (A). Weave in all threads. Enjoy!



Legend:

-  15/0 seed bead - A
-  11/0 cylinder bead - B
-  #1 bugle bead - C

One (1) Bugle set = (B,C,B,C)

(NOTE: two (2) bugle sets = one (1) star point).
