




**OVERVIEW:**

Make a basic triangle using bugles, cylinders and seed beads. Increase corners and sides for larger triangles. Connect multiples to form 3-D shapes.


**MATERIALS:**

- 12  15/0 seed bead
- 24  11/0 cylinder bead
- 6  #1 bugle bead


**TOOLS AND NOTIONS:**

- Braided Wire = 6# Fireline®
- Scissors (for braided wire)
- Beading Needles - Size 12


**1** Thread 12 inches (30.5cm). Leave a 6 inches (15.2cm) tail, string as follows:




**2** Form circle, needle forward, exiting bugle opposite start.




**3** Corner Increase



**4** Side Increase




**5** Finish: Weave in threads, cut.



**Designer Ideas:**

Zip-stitch 4 triangles to make a Tetrahedron.



Or

8 triangles for an Octahedron.
